Eligibility

EDU pedagogy classes are for lateral entry students. Students should provide either a signed Plan of Study from RALC (NCDPI Regional Alternative Licensing Center), or a CMS/CTE LTAP letter. Prospective students will also need a four-year degree from a regionally-accredited university or the required degree for their licensure area.

Cost

Courses are \$76 per credit hour, plus fees (based on 2018 – 19 tuition and fees for North Carolina residents).
